On December 20th our Spectrum staff will have an opportunity to spend an afternoon at a local Tijuana **senior's home** we've been working with for the last several years. Why is that noteworthy? Because throughout Covid, in order to protect the twenty plus residents from the effects of the virus, they've been closed to any visitors. To comply, Julian and Arturo have simply helped out by monthly stopping by with a truck full of food and supplies, but we've been unable to go in and visit. That's a long time! So the director has invited our Spectrum staff to come in and host a Christmas party. We plan to spruce the place up by hanging lights and bringing a Christmas

tree to decorate. Palau and Danny will play Christmas music on their guitars and because they love board games, we'll bring giant checkers and chess to play. Oh and let's not forget the food! We'll make home made meals to bring and enjoy. It's not a proper Christmas party without that! We're grateful for this opportunity God has given us. It's a chance to bring friendship to an otherwise lonely place.

The very next day, December 21st, a small team from our staff will go into the **teen jail** to celebrate Christmas with the inmates. Coming off last month's retreat where eleven young men and two young ladies gave their life to Christ, we're excited to share this first Christmas in which for them, the season has all new meaning! worth to Him. In fact, how He feels about them is what drove Jesus to come so many years ago!
